



## **TMPCC PRESS RELEASE: 01/01/2025**

The Television Motion Picture Car Club (TMPCC) is the world's only car club for those who work in, have worked in, or are associated with the television, motion picture, music, radio, sports or motorsports industries. They are a private club and membership is by invitation only.

The club was the brain child of Ken Latka, a Television Editor and Post Production Supervisor at CBS Television City in Hollywood, California. Ken realized that after more than 100 years of motion pictures and decades of television, the entertainment industry never had a car club, so he founded the TMPCC. On July 7, 2009, with the addition of Television Editor Harvey Berger as the club's first Vice President, Ken and Harvey came up with a name for the club, they created a website at [TMPCC.ORG](http://TMPCC.ORG) and the club was born. Ken served as TMPCC President from its inception in July 2009 until he retired from Television City in January 2020, at which time another entertainment industry pro, Cliff Greenough took over the helm. Harvey has since passed away, but Ken remains on the club's Executive Committee (EC) as a Senior Advisor, working with Cliff and the rest of the EC to oversee the club's continued growth.

TMPCC members include television and motion picture writers, producers, directors, actors, editors, camera operators, composers, audio mixers, audio designers, helicopter and jet film pilots, picture car builders, stuntmen and women, stunt coordinators, and even studio presidents. Many are Motion Picture Academy (Oscar), Television Academy (Emmy), Screen Actors Guild, and Taurus Stunt Award winners. They own a variety of vehicles, from daily drivers to exotics, sports cars, hot rods, classics, customs, muscle cars, trucks and motorcycles. The club welcomes all automotive enthusiasts who work in, have worked in, or are associated with the entertainment industry, regardless of what they drive.

The club also has several legendary stunt, precision and professional drivers who have performed some of the most amazing vehicle stunts captured on camera. Examples include the driving sequences in all the Fast and the Furious films, to earlier projects such as the Dukes of Hazzard and Knight Rider television series, along with hundreds of other movies and television shows that are listed on the [PRESS PAGE](#) of the TMPCC website. Some of the club's professional race car drivers have competed in the American Le Mans Series, the Baja 1000, FIA, Formula 1 Drift, Grand Am, the Trans Am Series, IMSA, IROC, NASCAR, NHRA, Rally, SCCA, X-Games, the 24 Hours of Le Mans, and other forms of motorsport. Several members have not only won races in those series, they have won Championships as well.

The club organizes several private "Members Only" events each year, and they also participate in public and charitable events run by other organizations. Some of the events the TMPCC hosts include Private Car Cruises, Private Members Meets, Private Tours of the most respected custom car shops in Southern California, such as Foose Design, Hollywood Hot Rods, Pure Vision Design and more.
